Steps to take if you are feeling unsafe;

- Tell a trusted adult (this can include your teacher, parent or carer)
- Telling a trusted adult will not get you in trouble
- Adults at school will listen to your concerns and help
- A trusted adult may need to tell another adult so that you can be helped

- If you are worried that another person is unsafe you should tell a trusted adult
